As part of Sutter CPMC’s neuroscience institute, our programs serve people with complex, catastrophic rehabilitation diagnoses at a facility within a tertiary hospital. This enables us to accommodate patients with the most complicated rehabilitation requirements, as well as any associated complex medical needs.

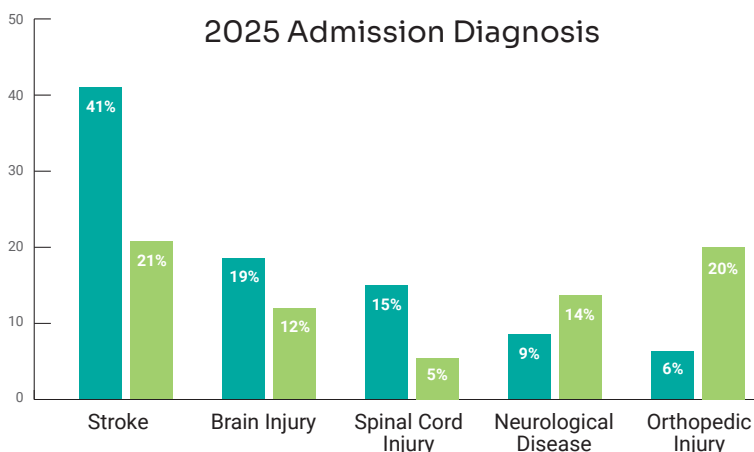

Constantly Improving

We use data analysis to regularly assess how effectively we serve our patients and community.

Uniform Data System for Medical Rehabilitation (UDSMR), an independent, not-for-profit data collection corporation, provides standardized reports that compare outcomes from medical rehabilitation providers. UDSMR translates our information into quality indicators (QIs): standardized, evidence-based measures that track performance.

We have a long history of proving our program’s effectiveness. According to UDSMR and data collector MedTel:

- CPRRC’s outcomes are consistently higher than national rates for all patients and for specialty programs.
- Our discharge to the community rate is consistently higher than national rates.
- Our readmission rate is consistently lower than national rates.
- Patient and family satisfaction rates exceed national benchmarks year after year.
